

APA 7 Statistical Reporting Checklist

Review tables and narrative results before manuscript submission.

Tables

- ☐ Every table has a number and concise italicized title.
- ☐ Labels, units, abbreviations, and reference categories are defined.
- ☐ Only decision-relevant statistics are retained.
- ☐ Notes explain significance conventions and unusual calculations.

Statistical results

- ☐ The estimate and its direction are stated.
- ☐ Confidence intervals are reported where useful.
- ☐ The effect-size measure is named precisely.
- ☐ Exact p values are reported when practical, with $p < .001$ for very small values.
- ☐ Degrees of freedom and test statistics are included where required.

Interpretation

- ☐ The text explains the result rather than repeating every table cell.
- ☐ Claims match the design and target population.
- ☐ Statistical significance is not presented as practical importance.
- ☐ Limitations, missing data, and multiplicity decisions are disclosed.
